Policy Statement:

School uniforms are compulsory for all students. Uniforms are valuable in contributing to a school's ethos and promoting positive values. What a child wears to school reflects his or her learning and indicates their readiness to work. It also enables students to take pride in their appearance and association with Newlands School.

1. Footwear

In particular, please note that **ALL BLACK** shoes must be worn with the school uniform and **ALL WHITE** footwear is permitted for PE only. Any other variations of footwear or uniform will not be allowed.

2. School Bags

A book bag or backpack is available from Threads. Parents may purchase their own bags or backpacks. School Bags and bag packs should be of appropriate size according to students height, age, and requirements.

3. Hair / Hair Covering/Nail/Make up

- Hair longer than collar length should be fastened back for PE and practical Science lessons.
- Hair may not be dyed any colour other than a student's natural hair colour.
- No make-up should be worn to school.
- Acrylic nails should not be worn.

4. Jewelry

Students should not wear excessive amounts of jewelry. It is not advisable to wear expensive jewelry to school. The following are permitted:

- Earrings: small sleepers or studs
- Rings: one plain ring may be worn but must be removed in PE or during practical lessons
- Necklaces: if worn should not be visible
- Watch: A watch/ smartwatch may be worn.

5. Additional Information:

- Students are required to attend school wearing PE clothes on PE lessons days.
- Full school uniform should be worn on days when your child has swimming and the swimming kit should be packed separately.
- All uniform items should be clearly labelled with the child's name.
